

How to Correct Your Writing in USALearns

Hi. I'm Diana, and I'll show you how to correct your writing in USALearns.

Sometimes in the course you'll do a writing activity called Write About It. After you write, be sure to click 'Done'. At the bottom, you will see 'Your changes were saved'. If you do not click 'Done', your teacher will not receive your writing.

Next time you study, you should look for a message from your teacher so you know what you did well and what corrections to make. On your home page, look in the top right corner for a yellow message. Click it, then look to find dates after you did your writing. Click 'Please review your assignment'.

To show you where to make the corrections, your teacher may use quotation marks, like two little lines at the beginning and the end of her message to you. Or she may use parentheses, that's one long line at the beginning and at the end of her comment for you.

Read your teacher's message and write on paper or type in a document the corrections you need to make. For example here, the teacher says 'Please remember to include a small word after 'like'. I like and then there needs to be a small word after.'

To make the corrections, you need to go to the Write About It activity. Click 'Write about it' to go to the writing and make the corrections.

Be sure to click 'Done' to see 'Your changes were saved'. Your teacher will then receive your writing.

To continue studying, you can click 'Next' to go to the next activity, or click 'Activity Menu' to study something else
